Management Commitment

Lack of management commitment is the greatest risk to your energy performance

What does Management Commitment look like?

- Endorsing an energy policy that includes clear commitments
- Allocating human and financial resources to energy management
- Endorsing and empowering an energy team
- Assigning responsibility for energy performance


