Circular Ambition:

Reduce waste by avoiding single use , Plant based vs Single use , GHG emissions reduction (embodied i plastics) , Reusable - local employment, Morale of the employee and employee engagement

Circular Outcomes:

What outcomes would you like to drive through this procurement? (i.e reduce waste by 50% or eliminate single use plastics)

GHG reduction by 45% by 2030 by reducing plastics (emedded GHG from transportation and manufacturing)
Reduction in waste diversion rate by % Vs Waste index - weight of waste - increase in waste diversion and decrease in waste weight (waste index)
increasing local job opportunities
Morale and employee engagement - how to measure
Cost savings ? - may not have savings

Circular Ambition:

Understanding Scope 3 emissions along with the purchase. End of Life Management. Taking responsibility following use. Is it more feasible to purchase or lease. Thinking about costs at end of life.

Circular Outcomes:

What outcomes would you like to drive through this procurement? Increase reparability or extend warranties to prolong life of asset.

Increasing/promoting reparability before replacing services (e.g., 5-year service agreement- refurbishing). Training staff to repair products.
Procure laptops with % of recycled content

Spend Category: Facility Management

Circular Ambition:

What is it that you want to achieve? Do you want to increase local jobs, reduce barriers to employment, reduce waste and carbon emissions through procurement?

- post covid: optimize facility usage: running facility is expensive. Opening up space to outside of organization; short term rental opportunity; repurposed into retail ; community opportunity.
- energy usage: optimize heating/lighting/energy to use facility, look into alternative energy sources/retrofit (solar, wind, other renewables)
- Light as subscription model: buying lumens instead of lightbulbs; no need for end of life management; refrigerators at grocery stores used as a service
- ensure partners/suppliers have sustainable policies

Support local development opportunities through reuse and repair

Reduce textile related waste by reusing uniforms by 75%
Reuse uniforms

Circular Outcomes:

What outcomes would you like to drive through this procurement? Encourage reuse or rent textiles instead of owning to reduce waste by 45%

Reduce textile waste by 75% through reuse or through uniform rentals

Increasing local economic develop opportunities through reuse and repair

More specific requirement needed where we explicitly state the need for various sizes according to gender.
